As Director, Directorate of Research and External Relations (2019 - till date)

Shortly after the inauguration of the Directorate In 2019, I was able to successfully facilitate the hosting of Prof. Lungi Sosibo as a visiting scholar from Cape Peninsula University of Technology, Cape Town, Western Cape, South Africa. Prof Sosibo was able to train the university research teams and other members of staff in grantsmanship and some specific aspects of research endeavors. We also had a 3 day workshop on components of an award

winning proposal; why research fail; timeline and research budget fundamentals...Research activities have since been resuscitated on campus after the training/workshops.

Leading from the front, I was the first university staff (after the VC, Prof Abayomi Arigbabu) to win the Tetfund National Research Fund (NRF) in 2019 to execute the research project titled: Development and validation of psycho-educational counselling intervention program to enhance post-abuse and post-traumatic stress disorder (PSTD) coping of survivors of child sexual abuse in Nigeria.

Since inception in 2019, I have been able to establish a beneficial collaboration with Digital Bridge Institute, Abuja and university staff (both academic and non-academic) are being trained on yearly basis in different aspects of computer usage - ranging from computer appreciation to statistical analysis using SPSS.

In 2020 I was able to secure approval for our proposal to host a Carnegie fellow, thus in March 2021, the university played host to Professor Mojubaolu Olufunke Okome, as a visiting fellow from Brooklyn College U.S.A.

In 2020/2021 session, with the support of Prof Mojubaolu Okome (Carnegie Fellow), we were able to secure a big donation of books to the TASUED university library at the end of her fellowship.

Since 2020, I have regularly organised training/workshops for staff development and empowerment, particularly in the area of research and writing winning grant proposals. This is an effort that has yielded and still yielding great results as staff have been winning grants at both local and international levels (e.g. Prof Ekine Adefunke; Dr Akinsolape Oyesipo etc).

Under my watch, the Directorate was able to sign an MoU with the university of Georgia in the United States of America in 2020.

I have successfully mentor 4 colleagues who have also won the NRF after me and more already have their concept notes accepted, hoping to secure approval of their proposal in due course. E.g. in 2022, Professors Adefinke Ekine and Rachel Akerele won the Tetfund National Research Fund. They have successfully completed their projects. In like manner, Professors Jimoh Owoyele and Olufunmbi Akorede are also winners of the Tetfund NRF for 2024.

I have consistently won the Institution Based Research (IBR) fund to execute research that are of direct benefit to TASUED since 2017 till date.

Several members of staff won the IBR from 2017 till date through the mentorship training received from the Directorate, under my watch.

I was able to also bring the ENACTUS group under the radar of committee as well as the Directorate of Research for support and mentoring. ENACTUS as a student volunteer group on campus has been doing excellently well, having won two grants to conduct their research on baby care.

In February 2024, I was able to facilitate the hosting of an international conference in collaboration with DePECOS Institution and Development Research Centre (DIaDERC).

In August 2025, I was also able to facilitate the hosting of another international conference in collaboration with the Institute of Educational Leadership Practitioners of Nigeria.

I facilitated the hosting of Dr Amanda Johnson between 11th - 15th of August 2025. Dr Amanda is the Director, Gerald H. Read Centre for Interantional and Intercultural Education, Kent State University, Ohio, U.S.A. Her visit was very eventful and we are in the process of finalising the signing of MoU with Kent State University.

Talks are on with Professor Ane Turner Johnson, the Chair, Rowan/CMSRU Institutional Review Board, Rowan University U.S.A. for possible collaboration and signing of MoU with the university.

I was able to construct concrete walk-way from the COSPED building to the classroom and the road, thereby, making it easy and convenient to walk from the office to classroom even when there is rain.

I was able to construct relaxation sheds and concrete seats for students at the front of the college building, thereby making it easy for students to relax and protected from sun and rain.

Light in the lecture halls were fixed and all conveniences at the lecuter halls were fixed for the comfort of students.

Staff offices were also attended to during my tenure.

My tenure as Dean produced the highest number of Associate Professors and Full Professors across the entire University.

Staff of the college were mentored on the criteria and requirements for promotion and several members of staff successfully presented themselves and earned promotion as and when due.

During my tenure, I was able to secure the permission of the university management on behalf of the College to cultivate cassava in order to generate fund for the College. (this was the first of its kind on campus).

I was involved in academic planning and development, specifically in the monitoring of academic calendar activities and schedules, as well as facilitating the planning of new academic initiatives and programs.

I was involved in liaising with other academic units, departments, and external bodies representing the university in academic planning and quality assurance forums.

I was also involved in preparing reports on academic activities, quality assurance, and research progress. Documenting best practices and lessons learned for continuous improvement.
